



## Adapted Assistance Program

### Help for people **with reduced mobility** in case of an **emergency**

The **Service de sécurité incendie** (fire department) keeps a list of those people who will require special assistance during an emergency (fire, natural disaster, etc.).

Thanks to this information, firefighters will know, even before they arrive at the site of an emergency, of the possible presence of someone requiring special assistance to leave the premises.

Anyone who has reduced mobility may register, free of charge, with the Adapted Assistance Program.

Information contained in the fire department's files remains strictly confidential. It cannot be used, even by the municipality, for any other purpose than ensuring the safety of people during an emergency.
